STUDENT ACHIEVEMENTS:

ACADEMICS:

The school has got 100% result in the academic Year. The credit of the excellent performance is attributed to a number of new initiatives undertaken by the teachers and the school.

OLYMPIAD:

Participation in the Science, Maths, English , G.K. Olympiads itself is the biggest competition where a student competes to outshine others. It infuses a healthy competitive spirit through reward based assessment. I am proud to say that majority of our students have bagged the prizes in in these exams.

ABACUS:

We are proud enough to exclaim that Bharat Mata school is the first school over Chattisgarh to introduce Abacus along with the academics. 89 students have successfully graduated themselves after completing 8 level course. On 12th January 2020 there was state level competition in abacus and it was a great day for our school as our student from class VII harsh got champion of champion award. And three of our students got champion award, 1st runner up and 3rd runner up.

ROBOTICS:

Robots have always been a captivating piece of technology programmable to move, make noise, light up and follow instructions as directed. Our school also included robotics as our curriculum for classes IV - VIII from last five years and students are learning new technology. This year also students successfully completed their sessions with programmable and manual robots. For giving more opportunity we are working more specially for lower classes.

COMMUNICATIVE ENGLISH:

Strenuous efforts are taken to provide communicative English to the students which made a good impact in the language skills. Various activities and drilling in the language exercises, digital conversations and video clips are very helpful to the students to improve their language.

CO- CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Co-curricular activities provides children opportunities to showcase their talents. House wise and open House competitions were conducted throughout the year. By providing a conducive and encouraging environment, the students are mentored to participate in a variety of intra and interschool activities/competitions. It enables the student to grow in confidence, knowledge & enhance their all-round development.

Some of the co-curricular activities that are held in the school on every Saturday are:

Clay moulding, building blocks, origami flower making, poem recitation, fancy dress competition, handwriting competition, diya decoration, puppet making, book mark making, greeting card making, mask making, solo dance competition, rakhi making, best out of waste, salad making, thali decoration, mehendi competition, fireless cooking etc.

Aside from individual activities, group activities were also conducted according to house wise.

STUDENT ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

To ensure that our students are equipped to face any challenge, we have focused on few Student Enrichment programs which is as follows:

1. Career Counselling high school Students
2. Lectures on health hygiene
3. seminar on creative thinking
4. Seminar on stress management
5. Seminar on traffic rules
6. Seminar for Menstrual Health

Apart from these seminars, we also conduct the debated and speech competitions regarding the present issues of education and political India by which our students are exposed to various challenges that the country is facing at present.

Daily assembly is a great boon to the students at the beginning of the day to put forth their skills of language and general knowledge. To add a new flavour to the daily assemblies, themes are given to corresponding sections of the school, along with two days for the teachers to give thought for the day.

SCHOOL HOUSES:

The students of the school are divided into four different houses, Aryabhata, Bhaskaracharya, Varahamitra and Chanakya. Each House is managed by Teachers and Students as a House incharge and House leaders. SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY:

It is important for the children to realize how privileged they are to have wonderful parents like you. The school has conducted 2 social responsibility programmes during the year for the children to realize the importance of sharing and helping, they are help age India and smile foundation. LIBRARY

Library is called the heart of any educational institution as it is the food for the young brains. The library of the school is rich and well equipped . Our Library has been enriched with subscriptions for more number of newspapers, magazines, Educational periodicals and acquisition of a large number of books in fiction and in all school subjects both in Hindi and English.

SCIENCE EXHIBITION:

The science exhibition was held in the month of December . The students came forward with new creative ideas and models on topics given separately for every class. Many new concepts regarding the designing of future city, new energy concepts etc. were showcased by the students.

Medical Check-Up:

An Eye camp and a dental was conducted by the Doctors of Dhrishti Nethralaya for the primary students. In addition to this – Regular height , weight and chest measurements have been recorded for all the students in the beginning of the year. These will be compared with the year end measurements and reported to the parents in the final report. We remain grateful to all the parents for reposing their unparalleled trust in us which propels us to march ahead with greater commitment and enthusiasm.

SPORTS AND GAMES EVENTS

Strenuous exercise and interest in games is an outlet for the vigor of youth. Ample opportunities were provided to our children to play and prove their mettle in various sports and games at school, cluster, and inter-school level competitions. During this year Bharat Mata CBSE has proved itself in various inter school competitions and activities. The team of Bharat Mata achieved gold and silver medals in Inter School Sports Competition, held at SVS school, M.M. School and MAC college and the sports that they participated are caroms, badminton, basket ball, chess, table tennis, volley ball , singing, kho-kho, foot ball and swimming. The performance of our school in all these schools wherein more than ten schools and colleges participated, was commendable. In SVS school 34 of our students participated in sports events and bagged 10 gold medals and 6 silver medals. In M.M. School, our school kho-Kho team stood first by competing with 15 schools. In individual events, our students Raj and Shourya won 3 gold medals, 3 silver medals in swimming.
